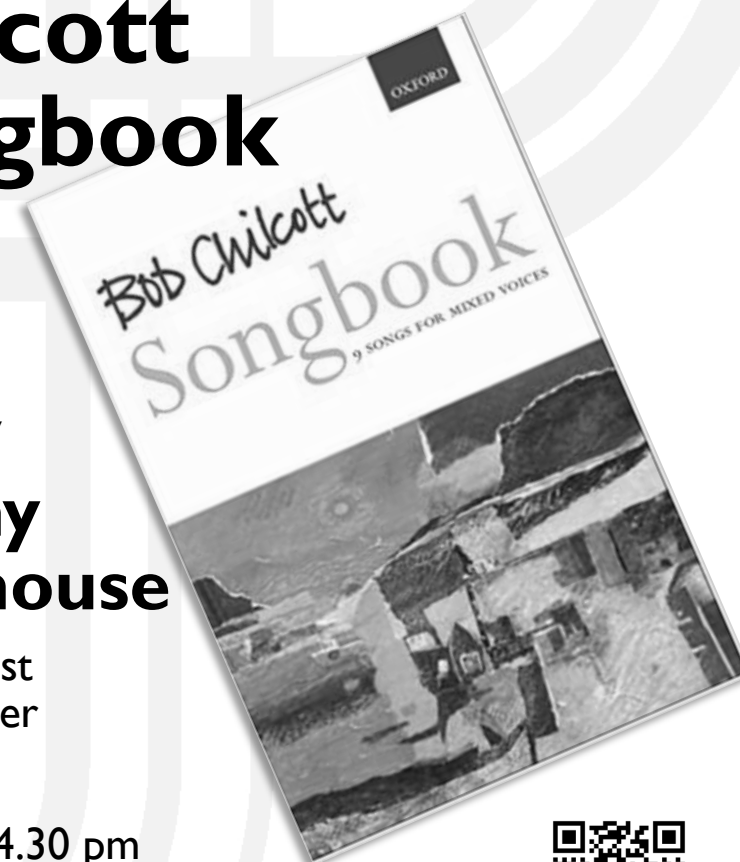

Bob Chilcott is one of Britain's most popular contemporary choral composers, best known for his *Little Jazz Mass*, *Requiem* and choral song *Can you hear me?* He spent twelve years as a member of the King's Singers before turning to full-time composition in 1997. Since then his music has been performed all over the world and frequently recorded and broadcast.

The **Bob Chilcott Songbook** is an anthology of nine of his most singable works, including original pieces and arrangements of favourite folk songs such as *O Danny Boy* and *The Skye Boat Song*.

Jeremy Backhouse is one of Britain's leading choral conductors. He conducts the 140-strong Vivace Chorus, Guildford, and the Vasari Singers, recognised as one of the finest chamber choirs in the country. Recent recordings with the Vasari Singers include the Vaughan Williams *Five Mystical Songs* with Roderick Williams, who also appears on their new CD of Christmas fun and festive carols, due for release in October. Jeremy champions contemporary choral music and has worked closely with Bob Chilcott, Roxanna Panufnik, Gabriel Jackson, Will Todd and many others. Jeremy has also worked with a number of the country's leading choirs, including the BBC Singers, the London Symphony Chorus, the Philharmonia Chorus, the London Choral Society and the Brighton Festival Chorus.



Petersfield Methodist Church is just two minutes' walk from the station, where there is a car park (entrance on Frenchman's Road) with ample parking at the weekend. Please bring your own lunch – or visit one of the many cafes within a few minutes' walk. Tea and coffee will be provided.
